As our presses have differing capabilities and hay grades vary in weight, these can influence the total cargo weight. Therefore pack quantities may be adjusted to comply with the country's cargo limit.

## Bridgewater, Victoria

Establishment Code: 1308

Located in the center of Victoria's grain growing region and is approximately 206km north-west of the port of Melbourne. Bridgewater uses small bale and big bale presses to produce the below bale options:

- Half Cut Bale
- Full Bale
- Mag Bale
- Big Bale - Sleeved - TMR Ready



## Brookton, Western Australia

Establishment Code: 4016

Located at the southern end of Western Australia's grain growing region and is approximately 130km south-east of the port of Perth. Brookton uses a small bale press to produce the below bale options:

- Half Cut Bale
- Full Bale
- Double Bale



## Paskeville, South Australia

Establishment Code: 3974

Located in the center of South Australia's grain growing region and is approximately 126km north-west of the port of Adelaide. Paskeville uses a small bale press to produce the below bale options:

- Half Cut Bale
- Full Bale
- Double Bale



## Yerecoin, Western Australia

Establishment Code: 2152

Located at the northern end of Western Australia's grain growing region and is approximately 150km north-east of the port of Perth. Yerecoin uses small bale and big bale presses to produce the below bale options:

- Half Cut Bale
- Full Bale
- Big Bale - Sleeved - Biscuit
- Big Bale - Sleeved - 4 Cut
